

Congratulations on receiving your gift of crypto-currency! You have been gifted the revolution. If you haven't received crypto before, welcome to the club; you have joined millions of others who are working to build a more open, transparent financial system.

You have received your money in a paper wallet. Store this wallet in a safe place. The wallet is like cash. If the wallet is lost or destroyed or stolen, the crytpo-currency stored on the wallet is gone with it.

The Wallet

The wallet contains several important panels.

- Public: This panel contains a QR code and a key. Both can be used to receive and send money in crypto-currency transactions. If you want to add more crypto to the wallet, you would give this public key or scan the QR code. Either will work. If you want to spend your crypto on the wallet, you'll be asked to provide your public key or your QR code. This information is okay to divulge to the public.
- Private: This contains your private key. Never divulge this key or QR code. This should only be used when you want to transfer the currency from your paper wallet to a different wallet. If someone gets the private key, they can take ownership of your crypto and there is nothing you can do to stop it.
- Stats page: This page shows the amount of crypto stored on the wallet, the date the wallet was set up, the price the crypto was purchased, and the recipient of the wallet.
- The other pages are filler.

Coins on the Chain

To see your coins on the blockchain, do the following:

- 1. Go to https://www.blockchain.com/explorer
- 2. Type in your public key.
- 3. This will show you the block on the chain where your coins reside.
